Burglaries Dunsmore.

For your information, there have recently been 2 break-ins in Dunsmore with property being taken from garages/outbuildings. Please be vigilant and report any suspicious activity to the police.

Road Closures.

Chalkshire Road. Chalkshire Road will be closed from 9.30am till 15.30pm on Friday 29 October 2021 for Openreach to replace a telegraph pole.

North Lee Lane, Marsh Lane. HS2 are going to remove vegetation from the area surrounding the railway level crossing at the end of North Lee Lane and plan to close the road from 09.00 on Friday the 4th of November until 17.00 on Monday the 8th of November. Also in early November HS2 are planning to deliver by train a considerable amount of material (thousand of tons) to this area to make a new track bed for the railway as it needs to be re-aligned. The deliveries will take place at night and there may be noise and light pollution.
